PROGRAM INFORMATION

This program curriculum is designed to educate a school administrator who is trained to work for an early childhood, school-level, or post-secondary institution. Additionally, a student should be able to build their own educational institution from ground up. Future Administrators will be able to design and implement educational programs not only in their native language, but also in English. Students study a core of general education subjects combined with specialized courses related to a wide spectrum of educational services. Part of the curriculum consists of hands-on experiences in the field of early childhood, middle childhood, or youth such as those in private/public settings, including daycare centers, private and public secondary schools, and higher education institutions.

CREDIT STATEMENT
